Strategy Statement for Financial year 2018/19

Little Waltham Parish Council intends to achieve the following objectives during the financial year 2018/19 –

- To continue to keep the Parish in a clean and tidy condition by arranging for litter to be picked up and bins to be emptied on a regular basis
- To maintain a tidy Parish by arranging for the cutting of grass in certain public areas
- To meet the administrative costs of the running of the Parish Council in the discharge of its statutory duties including the cost of employing the Clerk
- To maintain a pleasant standard of living in the Parish by arranging for gardening within the Parish including the trimming of certain hedges and the maintenance of plant pots and arrangements
- To continue to provide recreational facilities for the Parish by maintaining the recreation ground including the hard play area and the children's play area at Brook Hill. In particular to mend the fencing around the hard play area.
- In view of the age of the equipment in the Brook Hill children's play area to improve that area by the acquisition of one new piece of play equipment during the financial year
- To provide grants for voluntary non-profit making community groups
- To continue to provide and maintain allotments within the Parish including the improvement of the allotment plots behind the recreation ground
- To consider the provision of a Community Defibrillator
- To continue the maintenance of certain trees within the Parish for which the Parish Council has a responsibility to comply with Health and Safety requirements
- To communicate with residents by continuing to maintain a website and by the continuation of the Parish Council magazine.
