


Pandemic planning (second wave)



Positive actions during Covid 19 so far

Positive Actions

- Substantial amount of relevant information and sources of support communicated to residents via the Parish Council Facebook page
- Good communication with Channels Residents Group and provision of volunteers to assist with leaflet distribution. Also good communication with the Tufnell Hall and Memorial Hall reps.
- Parish Council continued to function and meet statutory responsibilities in particular by use of Zoom meetings

Negatives to be considered

- No communication forthcoming from the local GP surgery
- Communication from other local authorities was limited (Chelmsford City Council and Essex County Council)
- Were Residents clear of the role of the Parish Council during the crisis
- The Parish Council only has one employee and to consider future contingency planning in the event that the Clerk were to be ill or unavailable
- Lack of certainty as to whether all those in need within the Parish were aware of support resources as the majority of publicity was digital

Conclusions and next steps
