Risk Assessment

This risk assessment relates to the Tennis court in the recreation grounds at Brook Hill

The 'Roadmap out of lockdown' advises that Tennis Courts may be re-opened as from 29 March 2021.

Risk of injury in the case of faulty equipment	users	General Maintenance Issues	Ensure no safety issues regarding use of area	Weekly inspections will be carried out once the area has re-opened and quarterly operational inspections will continue. Risk factor Low
Spread of Covid 19	Users of the area	Social Distancing : Social distancing aims to reduce social interaction between people to minimise the opportunity for transmission of COVID-19.	Put in place measures to support social distancing – 2m or 1m plus risk mitigations.	Signage to be erected to advise of need to socially distance. The Parish Council has noted that the area has low useage and is in a rural area and thus such measures will reduce the risk to users. Signage will be regularly checked.
Spread of Covid 19	Users	Cleaning and Hygiene :		The only touch point is the entrance gate and in view of the low useage the Parish Council considers signage reminding users to use hand sanitisers will reduce any risk accordingly.

Conclusion – The tennis court may be re-opened on 29 March 2021 subject to the erection of appropriate signage
