### Grass Cutting Specification Areas to cover and frequency

Area	Clarifications	Frequency
Area A - Ash Tree Corner	As shown edged red on the arial view map	From 1 April until 31 October on a fortnightly basis
Area B – The recreation grounds including the football area, former cricket pitch and children’s play area	The area shown coloured red on the attached plan with the exception of the area marked A which is the allotment gardens and B which is the tennis court. The strip of land between the car park and 21 Brook Hill is a hedge and is not included in this contract. The children’s play area may be accessed via the large wooden gate. Please note you may need to strim around certain objects such as play equipment and concrete edging.	From 1 March until 31 October on a fortnightly basis
Area C – The Street entrance by the School	As shown on the attached map – please note a number of flower tubs have been installed by the Parish Council to deter parking so you may need to consider strimming in certain areas	From 1 April to 31 October on a fortnightly basis

#### Standard of work

- To complete the grass cutting to a standard that is free from undulations and where large amounts of grass are cut the grass mowings must be evenly spread.
- Prior to mowing the contractor must pick up any obstructions and remove any non grass debris from each area at the end of the cut.
- Please exercise care when mowing in the vicinity of members of the public, animals or parked cars
- In the event that it is necessary to strim an area please avoid damage to tree bases by providing a margin of 100mm. Trees damaged as a result of incorrect strimming practises should be replaced at the contractor’s cost.
